## The 5 Solas:


Sola Gratia (Grace Alone)

# Grace= Unmerited Favor. Unearned, Undeserved Blessing.



## Ephesians 2:1-3

John 3:36


## Grace is God moving in us to understand Him and be aware of our need for Him through Christ.

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. Redemption: 1. the action of saving or being saved from sin, error, or evil. 2. the action of regaining or gaining possession of something in exchange for payment, or clearing a debt.

## Ephesians 2:4-10

But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, seven when we were dead in our transgressions, 1 made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and 2raised us up with Him, and 3seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the ages to come He the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness us in Christ Jesus. For by grace you have been saved through(faith;) and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

## 1 Corinthians 15:10

But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me did not prove vain; but I labored even more than all of them, yet not I, but the grace of God with me.

## 2 Corinthians 9:8

And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed;

## Romans 11:5-6

In the same way then, there has also come to be at the present time a remnant according to *God's* gracious choice But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works, otherwise grace is no longer grace.
