SOLA CHRISTUS

Judaizers are Christians, both Jewish and non-Jewish, who teach that it is necessary for Christians to adopt Jewish laws and customs, especially those Jewish laws and customs which are prescribed in the Law of Moses (see also Torah).

15 But some men came down from Judea and were teaching the brothers, “Unless you are circumcised according to the custom of Moses, you cannot be saved.”² And after Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and debate with them, Paul and Barnabas and some of the others were appointed to go up to Jerusalem to the apostles and the elders about this question.

7 And after there had been much debate, Peter stood up and said to them, “Brothers, you know that in the early days God made a choice among you, that by my mouth the Gentiles should hear the word of the gospel and believe. 8 And God, who knows the heart, bore witness to them, by giving them the Holy Spirit just as he did to us, 9 and he made no distinction between us and them, having cleansed their hearts by faith. 10 Now, therefore, why are you putting God to the test by placing a yoke on the neck of the disciples that neither our fathers nor we have been able to bear? 11 But we believe that we will be saved through the **grace of the Lord Jesus, just as they will.” Acts 15:7-11**

²¹ I do not nullify the **grace** of God, for if **righteousness** comes through the Law, then **Christ** died needlessly.” Galatians 2:21

²Behold I, Paul, say to you that if you receive ^Lcircumcision, **Christ** will be of no benefit to you. ³And I testify again to every man who receives ^Lcircumcision, that he is under obligation to keep the whole ^LLaw. ⁴You have been severed from **Christ**, you who are seeking to be justified by ^Llaw; you have fallen from **grace**. Galatians 5:2-4

²¹ He made Him who knew no sin ~~to~~ ~~be~~ sin on our behalf, so that we might become the **righteousness** of God **in Him.**

¹⁷ For if by the ~~transgression~~ of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of **grace** and of the gift of **righteousness** will reign in life through the **One, Jesus Christ.**

¹⁸ So then as through one ~~transgression~~ there resulted condemnation to **all** men, even so through **one act** of **righteousness** there resulted **justification** of life to **all** men. ¹⁹ For as through the one man's ~~disobedience~~ the **many** were made ~~sinners~~, even so through the obedience of the **One** the **many** will be made **righteous**

Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are **in Christ Jesus.** ² For the law of the Spirit of life **in Christ Jesus** has set you free from the law of sin and of death. ³ For what the Law could not do, weak as it was through the flesh, God *did*: **SENDING HIS OWN SON** in the likeness of sinful flesh and *as an offering* for sin, He condemned sin in the flesh,

SOLA FIDE (Faith Alone)

²⁸ For we maintain that a man is **justified** by **faith** apart from works of the **Law**. Romans 3:28

¹⁶ nevertheless knowing that a man is not **justified** by the works^W of the Law^L but through **faith**^F in **Christ Jesus**, even we have believed **in Christ Jesus**, so that we may be **justified** by **faith**^F in **Christ** and not by the works^W of the Law^L; since by the works^W of the Law^L no flesh will be **justified**. Galatians 2:16

⁴ Now to the one who works, his wage is not credited as a favor, but as what is due. ⁵ But to the one who does not work, but believes **in Him** who **justifies** the ungodly, his **faith** is credited as righteousness, Romans 4:4-5

Therefore, having been **justified** by **F**faith, we have peace with
God through our **Lord Jesus Christ**, Romans 5:1

8 For by **grace** you have been saved through **faith**; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; 9 not as a result of ^Wworks, so that no one may boast. 10 For we are His workmanship, created **in Christ Jesus** for good ^Wworks, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them. Ephesians 2:8-10

¹⁷ Even so **F**faith, if it has no **W**works, is dead,  *being* by itself.

¹⁸ But someone may *well* say, “You **W**have **F**faith and I have **W**works; show me your **F**faith without the works, and I will show you my **F**faith by my **W**works.” ¹⁹ You believe that God is one. You do

well; the demons also believe, and shudder. ²⁰ But are you willing to recognize, you foolish fellow, that **F**faith without **W**works is useless? James 2:17-26

²¹ Was not Abraham our father **justified** by works when he offered up Isaac his son on the altar? ²² You see that **faith** was working with his works, and as a result of the works, **faith** was perfected; ²³ and the Scripture was fulfilled which says, “And Abraham believed God, and it was reckoned to him as **righteousness**,” and he was called the friend of God. James 2:17-26

A supposed contradiction?

²⁴ You see that a man is **justified** by works ^W and not by **faith** ^F alone. ²⁵ In the same way, was not Rahab the harlot also **justified** by works ^W when she received the messengers and sent them out by another way? ²⁶ For just as the body without *the* spirit is dead [☠], so also **faith** ^F without works ^W is dead. [☠]

²⁴ You see that a man is **justified** by works and **not by faith alone**.

It is not works plus faith but works from faith.
