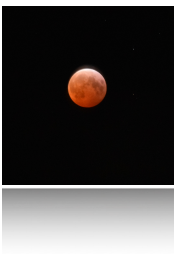

A WEDDING IN CANA

I've been in a Bible study lately in the Gospel of John. Last week we were looking at John 2:1-11. There are many things I could share with you that I gleaned from this passage but I'll simply share two things here.

Bring it to Jesus.

Jesus and his disciples get invited to attend a wedding, which seems to be a very intentional thing. Usually we only invite people to attend ceremonies like this if they are special to us or they have some kind of influence and having them present makes the event that much more special.

Is it possible that Jesus' mother was a little responsible for this wedding? She's the one that comes to Jesus to inform Him about the need for more wine. This seems to be the role of someone connected to the family or in some position of responsibility. Whatever the case, Mary brought the issue to Jesus. She knew that there was a dire need and He could do something about it.

Running out of wine at an event like this would cause extreme embarrassment for the family. Just like any of us would be embarrassed if we didn't have enough at a wedding, Mary senses the responsibility to cover for this family by getting Jesus involved. What is it that you need to bring to Jesus and let Him get involved?

I'm not quite sure how long it was into the celebration that they knew they were going to run out but they waited until it was all gone before bringing the situation to Him. Isn't this just like us? We wait until we've exhausted every other option before coming to Him.

Do whatever He says.

Mary tells the servants explicitly that! It's a simple thing, isn't it? And yet for some of us that can be a hard thing to do...doing exactly what the Lord says. We often want to understand or perhaps only "half-obey". We are told the servants filled the jars "to the brim". I have found that I don't have to understand to obey. Obedience leads to blessings!

I WAS ON THE LAST FLIGHT HOME FROM LEBANON!

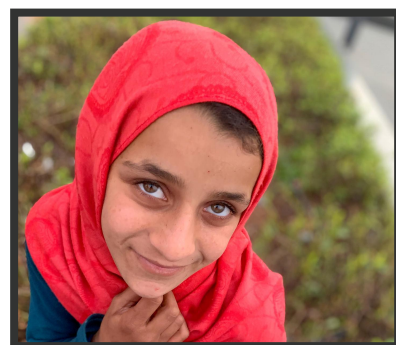

Randall and I spent several days wandering through the streets and wondering what the best thing for me to do so as to not get stuck there. While there I did get to see some beautiful things but the trip was hindered by the virus.

After lots of questions and several phone calls, I decided to stay the full length of my itinerary. However, when it was time to leave, I found out that I was actually on the very last flight leaving the airport that day back to the States! Wow! That's a praise God moment, right? The eighth before leaving, I had an interesting encounter. Here's an excerpt from my journal for the 16th of March:

Well, last night I met a deaf guy and his family. It was a little crazy because we were simply walking back from dinner and Randall wanted to make a couple of stops. Along the way I saw this cross and wanted to get a picture. But because the first one I took I didn't really like, I wanted to get another and at the point I was going to take it, the lights went out. I was like "are you kidding me"! Then they came on so I snapped one quickly. Then they went off again. And back on. At that point I knew someone was messing around with me. I looked back and it was the owner of a little corner market. I saw him speaking to an older gentleman and it looked like sign(language) so I asked if he was deaf and sure enough. We had a great conversation and exchanged numbers. So all of that to say, God led me to the cross to meet these deaf people. It's through the cross that the deaf will be able to hear.

The picture here is of a young girl who was on the streets begging one of the days we were out walking about. We gave her some money for her picture. Please continue to pray for Randall and the ministry in Lebanon. Randall will be in the states next week for a few months raising support.
